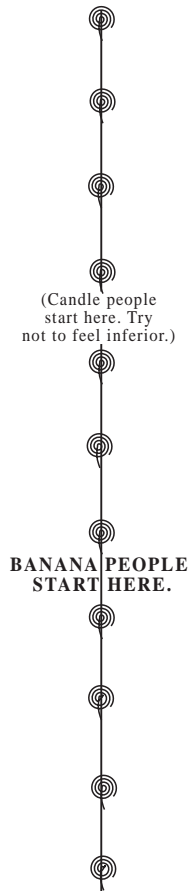


# You chose the BANANA

c) Move down three and take your stinking banana breath with you.

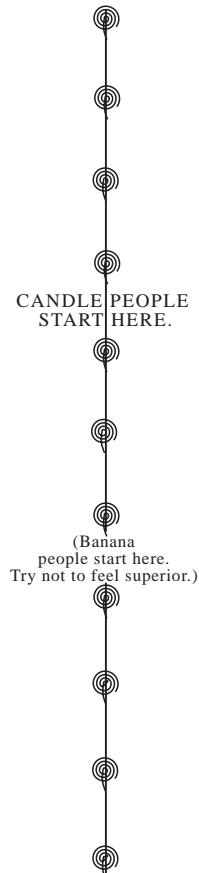
